- And the mandatory documents referred to in Section 50 (2) as captured in the table below:

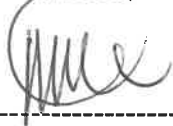

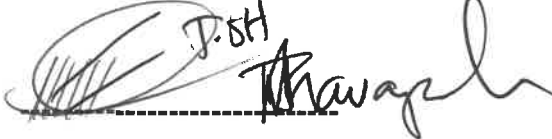
